Dear Parents and Carers,

Our Year 11 students are allowed to go on study leave today. We believe that they have reached the point in their learning where they can continue with their studies independently, with access to support from their teachers should they require it.

### **Independent study**

We strongly advise your child to make use of the technology and revision tools we have provided. They can contact their teachers via their school e-mail address. They can also make use of the online platforms that we have provided such as Sparx Maths, Sparx English, and Sparx Science to support their learning.

I highly recommend that you encourage your child to maintain a good routine, including getting up at normal school time, following the school timetable as closely as possible for their revision, and engaging in at least six hours of learning a day.

I recommend that your child gets a good night's sleep throughout the exam period and ensures that they have good nutrition and hydration (no energy drinks).

### **Attending school**

Any students who wish to continue to follow their school timetable are able to do so. If your child is attending school, they must attend school at 8:30AM as per our normal arrangements and will remain on site until 3:00PM.

### **Behaviour**

We want to remind our students that whilst they remain on roll at our school, the Behaviour Policy and Exam Regulations still apply. This includes any conduct outside of school which may bring the school's reputation into disrepute.

Students must attend the examinations on time and in full school uniform.

For a morning exam, students will be expected to attend school at 08:30AM as normal.

For an afternoon exam, students will be expected to attend at 12:30PM.

Students who attend school earlier than these times will follow their normal timetable.

Students wishing to continue with study leave will be permitted to leave the school site immediately after their examination only. Please note that students who choose to remain on site will be dismissed at 3:00PM with the rest of the school. Students will not be permitted to leave throughout the school day.

## Students in receipt of free school meals (FSM)


