74% of pupils achieved Good Level of Development (GLD), which was better when compared to both the local authority and national outcomes.

84% of pupils in Year 1 and 74% of pupils in Year 2 achieved the benchmark score in the Phonics Screening Check. This was better when compared to both the local authority and national outcomes.

| Year 4 | 64% | 85% | 37% |

85% of pupils in Year 4 scored 25 marks out of 25 on the Multiplication Table Check. This was significantly better than last academic year (64%).
