Considerate Parking and Respect for Our Neighbours

At Waverley School, we are proud to be part of the Yardley Green Road community and we value the positive relationships we have with our neighbours. We are writing to ask for your support in ensuring that these relationships remain strong and respectful.

We recognise that the start and end of the school day can create pressure on local roads, particularly given the location of our schools and Heartlands Hospital. We appreciate that most parents and carers already act responsibly when dropping off and collecting our children. However, we have recently received concerns from local residents regarding parking and driver behaviour in the surrounding area.

We therefore ask all parents and carers to help by:

We hope you will agree that any form of abusive, aggressive or intimidating behaviour towards local residents is wholly unacceptable and does not reflect the values of our school or our Trust.
