Dear Parents/Carers,

Christmas and Festive Activities

The School Christmas Post box is up and running. If your child would like to send Christmas cards to friends at Waverley School, the free post service has begun. Remind your child to write the name and class on the envelope. We can only make deliveries to children and adults in school.



The annual school Christmas Dinner will take place on **Wednesday 15th December**. If you would like your child to receive a Christmas Dinner and they usually have a packed lunch, please make a payment of £2.05 on Parent Pay by **Friday 10th December**. On this date, numbers will need to be passed on to the caterers and therefore, it is essential the payment is made in time to avoid any disappointment.



'Christmas Jumper Day' - We will also be raising funds for 'Save the Children' and ask that all pupils make a donation of £1.00 and wear their Christmas jumper on **Wednesday 15th December**.

We have arranged for Hobgoblin Theatre Company to come into school on Wednesday 15th to perform a pantomime for all pupils. The performance of 'The Wind in the Willows,' will be shown to all primary pupils.

Our class Christmas parties will take place on the afternoon of **Thursday 16th December**. Children are allowed to wear their party clothes for school. We would also be grateful if your child could bring along some packaged party food (e.g. crisps, savouries, cakes, buns, biscuits). In order to keep all children safe from food allergies, please do not send in any homemade baked goods.
