I hope you all have a safe and fun half term holiday together. I look forward to hearing about all the fun things you have done.



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





This half term started with pupils in both EYFS and Year 1 studying Dr Seuss.


In EYFS they studied the text 'What Pet Should I get'. They looked at all the different pets in the book talking about what they are like, the different names of baby and adult animals and how to look after them. They talked about the pets that different children in the Year Group have—from parrots to racing pigeons, cat and dogs.

They explored rhyme and practised creating their own rhyming strings. Year 1 recapped their previous learning about rhyme and extended it to learn about rhyming couplets — two lines that rhyme with the two following lines.





After studying the rhyming couplets in 'The Cat in the Hat' Year 1 had a go at writing their own rhymes for what they would do on a cold wet day.

#### Let it Snow!


This half term our focus has been Cold Places with our main text 'Lost and Found'. We have read a lot of books over the half term and children have grown in confidence using their phonics to write words and


sentences. We are really proud of the progress children have made since the first term.

#### **Phonics**

Over half term please practise these with your children using the **homework** packs provided. Can they write and read the sounds? Can they write any words using the sounds? Can they read and write the tricky words?


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# To Infinity & Beyond

This half term in Year one our key text has been Mae Among the Stars. A book inspired by the life of the first African American woman to travel in space, Mae Jemison.

We talked about her life and experiences, about how she was able to achieve her aspirations. Children created a timeline of her life and practised saying sentences using time connectives.

We followed it by learning about British astronaut Tim Peake, who was the first official British astronaut to walk in Space. We learnt about his

experiences, writing a fact file about his time in space and the Seed Project.

We were fortunate enough to see one of Tim Peaks space suits while we were at the National Space Centre.







#### **Phonics**

This half term we have completed phase 5b. We have been focussing on writing sentences using the new sounds, and remembering what we have been taught in English lessons about capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.

You can help your child by supporting them to recall the phase 3 tricky words. Being able to read and write them.



During the first week of February children across the Primary phase learnt about the importance of Chinese New Year. For the week children across the phase studied the Chinese New Year story as part of whole class reading, cumulating in an assembly.

In the EYFS they learnt about the importance of Chinese new year and traditions linked to it, including the importance of he colour red. They even sampled different foods from China—including prawn crackers and noodles. In the continuous provision they explored Chinese writing and crafts linked with the event. They made their own tiger masks using a range of resources.

Reach for the stars




Year One visited the National Space Centre in Leicester as part of their Out of this World Topic. Pupils were given a sense of what it's really like

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
