Primary Uniform

Many of you will be aware that the Government has published new statutory guidance on uniform. The main aim is that uniform is more affordable for parents. To further reduce costs, we are proposing we take away all branded items from our current PE kit. At the moment, the expectation is that pupils wear a Waverley branded blue polo t-shirt and fleece. We would like this to be a **plain white t-shirt and black fleece**, which should be accessible from all retailers.
