Dear Parents and Carers,

What a wonderful half term it has been for our Waverley family! Once again, our pupils have excelled with their commitment towards learning and expecting the very best from themselves and each other. Learning opportunities have been exciting and varied: Reception pupils have been inspired by the story of 'The Little Red Hen' and visited Hatton Adventure World where through first hand experience they discovered further facts about animals, their diet, and habitats. Year 2 pupils and parents created amazing 3D habitats, from lush rainforests to serene ocean floors, their masterpieces burst with colour and detail, showcasing a deep understanding of different ecosystems. Science Day was marked by inviting Hands on Science into school who delivered a number of workshops. Pupils experimented with colours, problem solved using pulleys, made scented candles and designed and constructed rollercoasters.

Assessments, Progress and Statutory Assessments

Last week, Primary pupils were assessed in Phonics, Reading, Writing and Maths. This information will be used to establish further support and interventions in summer 1. The summer term is an important term for all of our pupils as this is a period of assessments. Statutory assessments will take place for Year 1, Year 2, Year 4 and Year 6 pupils in May/June. Reminders of these will be sent out separately but it is essential that pupils attend school every day, arrive equipped to learn and consistently carry out homework and additional learning activities. We want all pupils to achieve their potential and for this reason will continue with the Booster sessions and Saturday classes.

A Trust Wide Grand Iftaar will be taking place on Thursday 21st March from 5pm – 8pm. This will take place in the main hall at Waverley School.
