Dear Parents and Carers,

We are writing to remind you of our expectations on pupil behaviour and attitudes in school. We are a school that prides itself on creating a happy and safe environment where everyone feels valued. This is essential for everyone to succeed. In our behaviour policy, we expect pupils to be:

1. Responsible
2. Respectful
3. Ready

We are incredibly proud of some of our recent achievements in English, Maths and other subjects; this is only possible when we have a school where everyone is respected, safe and able to learn.

Considering this and to ensure disruption to learning is minimised if a pupil does any of the following, they will be removed from the classroom:

- disrespectful behaviour to pupils or staff
- disrupting the learning of others in the room
- unkindness or demonstration of prejudice or discrimination in any form
- Unsafe behaviour that puts themselves or others at risk

If this occurs, we will contact you to inform you of the behaviour and to discuss next steps.

Regarding unstructured time if a pupil does any of the following in their break or lunch time, their free time will be removed. This includes:

- repeated failure to follow instructions
- behaviour that makes the environment less safe, including verbal and physical aggression

If poor behaviour is repeated, a meeting will be arranged to discuss specific behaviour strategies to improve behaviour. Failure to improve behaviour after support has been given will result in a serious conversation about next steps for that pupil.

I hope you can see the efforts the school is making to make sure your child gets the best education possible. We take our role incredibly seriously and ask that you support in keeping Waverley School high performing and a place where all children feel happy and safe, at all times.
